

Did you know?

Framingham is the hub of a multi-town region known as MetroWest, which offers a unique blend of urban, suburban and rural qualities.

- Founded in 1700.
- Maintains 3 historic districts and 7 buildings on the National Register of Historic Places.
- Located 20 miles from downtown Boston to the east and the City of Worcester to the west.

- **Population:** 66,173
- **Government:** Representative Town Meeting
- **Employment:** Framingham Public Schools, Framingham State College, the MetroWest Medical Center and Framingham Union Hospital, the Bose Corporation, Staples, Natural Microsystems, Perini, Lifeline, Genzyme, and TJX Headquarters.
- **Entertainment:** The Imax Theater, AMC Movie Complex, Amazing Things Arts Center, the Framingham Civic League, and Nevins Hall at Historic Memorial Building. Major regional shopping centers and an historic Downtown shopping district.
- **Culture:** Regional cultural institutions including the Danforth Museum of Art, the Mazmanian Art Gallery, Garden in the Woods, and the Framingham Historical Society and Museum.
- **Outdoors:** Numerous state and local parks, 6 major ponds, 3 local beaches, and golf courses right in town. Ski slopes and the ocean are just an hour away!
