FRAMINGHAM, MA – The people of Framingham and many others throughout the world have been in mourning since Friday morning when it was announced that Framingham’s own superhero, Devin Suau passed away surrounded by his loving family; His parents Christine and James and his older brothers, Colin, Owen and Brenden.

Our thoughts and prayers go out to the Suau family and to others in Devin’s Army who helped them through the past ten months. You have done yourselves and Framingham proud.

The Board of Health has made counselors available for confidential conversations with any member of our community who is having a difficult time processing this horrible tragedy.
