In accordance with the Framingham Home Rule Charter, Article X: Transitional Provisions, Section 7(w), *“The Council shall create a committee chaired by the City Clerk to create and oversee a community-wide process to design a new seal or adapt the current seal for the City of Framingham by 2020. The current Town seal shall remain the official seal of Framingham until such time as the Council has approved a replacement.”*
