Fuller Middle School Community Forum #3

FRAMINGHAM, MA – The Framingham School Building Committee will be hosting a community forum on Monday, February 12 at 6:00 PM in the Fuller Middle School Library for the Fuller Middle School Building Project. Parents, taxpayers and educational stakeholders are welcome to share their thoughts on the four design options and overlying educational vision for the revitalization of Fuller Middle School. Translators will be in attendance of this open forum so that a larger allocation of the community can join and learn about the Preliminary Design Program Report submitted to the MSBA (Massachusetts School Building Authority), and future steps in the MSBA process.

“It is critical that our entire community come together to better understand the need for this long overdue school project in the City of Framingham. As we look toward improving access to educational programming in our schools and making strategic investments in our educational system, it is important that we ask questions together - and hear the answers together. Quality educational systems have a direct correlation to a community's desirability and property value - let's talk through that so that we can, together, make the best decision that will impact Framingham for generations to come. I look forward to our dialogue on this important community project”, said Dr. Robert Tremblay, Superintendent of Framingham Public Schools.

The focal point of this forum is to create transparency with the community in understanding the design evaluation process and four design alternatives selected for study through an open and engaging discussion that the public and community is encouraged to attend for the valuable feedback they will provide.
