

RECYCLING CENTER

The Recycling Convenience Center is located at 255 Mt. Wayte Avenue. It serves the permitted residents of Framingham.

HOURS: Thursday (recycling only): 8 am — 3 pm
Friday — Saturday: 8 am — 3 pm
Sunday: 8 am — 3 pm

Obtaining a Permit

- Permits are available at the following locations:
 - Framingham Recycling Convenience Center
 - Public Works Colonna Building
100 Western Avenue
Monday - Friday 8 am - 3 pm
- Present vehicle registration at time of purchase and allow attendant to make a copy.
 - Registration must be non-commercial and have a Framingham address.
 - For lease vehicles the accompanying Insurance Policy showing a Framingham address must be presented.
 - Commercial registrations for home businesses are not acceptable. Vehicles with commercial lettering will not be permitted.
- Pay \$10 fee in cash or check and allow employee to place permit on lower driver side windshield.

RECYCLABLES ACCEPTED

- Plastic Containers #1 - #7
- Paper
 - Cardboard
 - Tin and aluminum cans
 - Glass jars and bottles
 - Clothing, shoes, linens (Textiles) and Books (in good condition for donation)



TRASH ACCEPTED

- 5 Bags per vehicle, per visit
- See "Bulky Item Disposal" for bulky items

UNIVERSAL WASTE ACCEPTED

- Fluorescent light bulbs (all sizes and shapes)
- Antifreeze
- Oil (in plastic container with screw on cap), oil filters
- Batteries: lead acid, rechargeable, lithium, mercury

YARD WASTE

Curbside Collection of yard waste is offered to all residential dwellings containing up to four (4) dwelling units.



Curbside collection of yard waste will occur on designated weeks on the same day as your trash.

Leaf Collection weeks are for the collection of leaves and other trimmings too small to be bundled.

No Brush.



- Leaves must be placed curbside in biodegradable bags or in barrels clearly marked "Yard Waste".
- Barrels must be 35 gallons in capacity or less.
- Bags or barrels must weigh 40 lbs or less

Brush Collection weeks are for the collection of sticks.

No Leaves.

- Brush must be no more than 4 inches in diameter and no more than 4 feet long.
- Brush must be tied and bundled in lengths of 4 feet or less and weigh no more than 40 lbs per bundle.
- Brush may be placed loose in a 35 gallon barrel marked "Yard Waste" and weighing 40 lbs or less.

YARD WASTE COMPOSTING

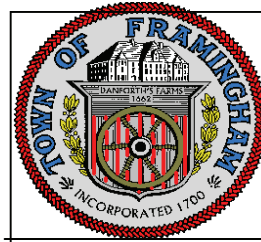
Compost bins are available at the Recycling Center for a fee.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

Curbside Collection of recycling is offered to all residential dwellings containing up to four (4) dwelling units.

RECYCLING BINS

Available at the Recycling Center or the Memorial Building (Town Hall) Room 213 open Monday - Friday 8:30AM - 4:30PM.

RECYCLING PREPARATION

Curbside Program is Single Stream: place all Recyclables in any bin, 35 gallon barrel or container labeled Recycling.

PAPER

- Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, paperboard (cereal boxes), phone books, paper bags, copy paper, notebook paper, posters, and junk mail.

CONTAINERS

- Clean glass bottles/jars (all colors and sizes), steel/ tin/aluminum cans and lids, aluminum pie plates, plastic bottles, jars, jugs, deli and yogurt containers #1 - #7. **NO Styrofoam.**

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

- **NO pizza boxes.**
- **NO plastic coated paper. NO plastic bags.**
- **NO dishes, mugs, glassware, light bulbs, windows, mirrors.**
- **NO aerosol cans or paint cans**

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE



Household Hazardous Waste Day is held yearly, often 2 times a year. The event is free to residents. Proof of residency required.

Call the Solid Waste Division or look for announcements on the town website and public access channel.

CURBSIDE TRASH COLLECTION

Curbside Collection of trash is offered to all residential dwellings containing up to four (4) dwelling units.

Weekly collection is limited to three (3) 35 gallon barrels, or equivalent of bagged trash, per residential dwelling unit.

Barrels or bags must weigh 40 lbs or less.

Waste must be placed out for collection after 6PM on the day prior to collection day or before 7AM on the day of collection.

Waste must not contain any of the following per Massachusetts Solid Waste Regulations 310 CMR 19.017 and/or Town Policy on Trash Collection:

- Recyclable Paper and Glass, Metal or Plastic containers
- Construction and Demolition Waste
- Leaf & Yard Waste
- TV's & Computer Monitors
- White Goods/Metal Items
- Lead Acid Batteries & Fluorescent Lights
- Tires & Automobile Parts
- Hazardous Waste
- Wood

- All waste must be securely contained within bags.
- The Sanitation Division is not responsible for cleanup of waste resulting from wildlife activity.



- **The Solid Waste Division will not collect barrels larger than 35 gallons, bags or barrels weighing more than 40 pounds or bags that are ripped or not securely tied.**

BULKY ITEM DISPOSAL

Curbside Collection of bulky items is offered to all residential dwellings containing up to four (4) dwelling units. Items must be scheduled.

Bulky items are defined as materials which require a fee for collection due to their size and/or weight or which cannot be disposed of as trash.

You have two options to dispose of bulky items:

1) Drop-off at the Recycling Center

- Metal Items - No Fee
- Softgoods (non-metal furniture) - \$12
- Sleep Sofa - \$25
- Freon Containing Items - \$15
- Carpeting - \$25
- TVs & Monitors - \$15
- Tires with or without wheels - \$2
- Propane Tanks - \$5

2) Curbside Collection

**** \$5 service fee for curbside pick-up ****

- Metal Items - \$12
- Softgoods (less than 40lbs *) - No Fee
- Softgoods (greater than 40lbs) - \$12
- Sleep Sofa - \$25
- Freon Containing Items - \$15
- TVs & Monitors (any size) - \$15
- Tires with or without wheels - \$2
- Propane Tanks - No curbside collection

***In place of 1 barrel per item placed at curbside.**

SCHEDULING

WHEN

- All softgoods are scheduled for your trash day
- All other items are scheduled for Wednesday

WHERE

- Memorial Building (Town Hall) Room 213 Monday - Friday 8:30AM - 4:30PM
- Recycle Center
Thursday—Saturdays: 8 AM - 3PM
Sundays: 11 AM - 3 PM

- **Scheduled items must be placed curbside or at the specified location no later than 7AM on the day of collection.**
