**General notes**

1. It may aid the voter if council districts and school committee districts are distinctly identified on the ballot, e.g., council district identified by number (1,2,3...) and school committee districts identified by letter (A,B,C...).
2. Census count usually finalized early in the year subsequent to the census – e.g., 2030 census, Town has number count by mid-year 2021, has to report to Secretary of State usually by fall, as state then has to redistrict house and senate seats for the 2032 election usually by the end of 2031. The precinct (maximum 4,000 voters) is the building block for all of this.
