

2022 Team Framingham Boston Marathon Charity Application Guiding Principles

- Charities to benefit from Team Framingham 2022 fundraising will be selected by random drawing lottery. Five charities will be chosen for the 2022 race.
- Charities will be accepted into the lottery by submitting a complete and verifiable charity application in advance of the submission deadline.
- Charities that obtain entries into the Boston Marathon directly through the Boston Athletic Association's official charity program are not eligible to participate in Team Framingham.
- All funds raised through the Team Framingham Boston Marathon program must be applied to programs that directly impact the Framingham community.
- Approved, eligible applicants will each receive one entry chance in the random drawing.
- Selection in the 2022 lottery is valid for the 2022 race only, for the selected charity only. Selection is non-deferrable and non-transferrable.
- Prior to applying, please be aware of the following expectations for selected charities:
 - Attend required charity orientation, date TBD in December or January.
 - Establish and manage the online fundraising campaign on the required online platform, following specific instructions from the Boston Athletic Association and Team Framingham Steering Committee.
 - Actively oversee and reconcile runner fundraising, including trouble-shooting and working directly with platform tech support as needed.
 - Actively support their runners' fundraising efforts by making donor introductions, using connections to encourage donations, planning fundraising events, etc.
 - Send at least one representative to each team meeting (to be held every 4-6 weeks).
 - Secure \$500 worth of banner sponsorships for each of your runners (1x\$500 or 2x\$250). Charities will be responsible for identifying the sponsors, coordinating the online donations, collecting and posting sponsor logos and runner photos in accordance with banner program guidelines and deadlines.
 - Manage at least one water stop during Team Framingham training runs, to be coordinated with the other charities.
- **Selection in the lottery does not guarantee assignment of Team Framingham runners or fundraising.** By law, the Team Framingham Steering Committee is not allowed to require runners to select any specific charity and cannot steer them towards any charity. Note that in past years, there have been charities with 10+ runners and others with one or two. To date, there has not been a situation where a charity had zero runners, but this is possible and no intervention is allowed to influence runner decisions.

- Charities will be given the opportunity to engage with runners and provide information about their programs. The format will depend on whether we are able to hold in-person meetings. Further instruction will be provided later.
- Selection in the 2022 lottery does not guarantee or prevent a charity from participation in Team Framingham in future years.

Please complete and review your application carefully! Applications that are incomplete or contain materially incorrect information will not be considered. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure accuracy and completeness.

- ✓ Articles of Organization with all amendments.
- ✓ Annual Report filed with Secretary of the Commonwealth within past three years.
- ✓ Copy of either:
 - IRS 501(c)(3) Determination Letter
 - IRS 501(c)(3) updated Affirmation Letter
