

## 2022 Team Framingham Boston Marathon Runner Application Guiding Principles

- The random selection application period will open on **Monday October 25, 2021** and run through **Friday November 19, 2021**.
- Random selection applications must be **received** no later than **4:00 PM** on **Friday, November 19, 2021**.
- Submission can be made via e-mail to [TeamFraminghamMarathon@gmail.com](mailto:TeamFraminghamMarathon@gmail.com) or via drop off or US mail to Jennique Horrigan, Marathon Bibs, Mayor's Office, Memorial Building, 150 Concord St. Framingham MA 01702.
- The random selection will be held in December on a date to be determined and announced during the registration period. It will be held in the evening and will be open to the public. This date is dependent upon when the BAA officially awards 2022 Boston Marathon entries to the City of Framingham.
- Random selection applications must be completed in full to be included. Applications not completed in full will be returned to the applicant.
- The applicant must be the person who will be running the Boston Marathon.
- The applicant/runner must meet one or more of the following three criteria:
  - Resident of the City of Framingham. Framingham State University students residing in on- or off-campus housing are not considered residents of Framingham for the purpose of determining residency unless their permanent residence is Framingham. Residency verification criteria can be found below.
  - Year-round or school year employee of the City of Framingham or the Framingham Public Schools, Keefe Technical School, or the Christa McAuliffe Charter School. Employment verification criteria can be found below.
  - Former Framingham employees who **retired** from service to Framingham within the last 10 years, with a minimum of 5 years of service, are eligible to submit applications.
- Residency and/or employment status will be verified **before** the random selection is held. Applicants not meeting the residency or employment criteria **will not** be included in the random selection. You will be informed if there is an issue with your application during the verification process.
- Applicants will be excluded from the random selection if they have failed to meet their fundraising requirement by the published deadline for a prior Boston Marathon through Team Framingham.
- The runner must be 18 years or older on April 18, 2022, the date of the 2022 Boston Marathon. This is a BAA requirement.
- **The runner is responsible for the “invitational entry fee” paid to the Boston Athletic Association (BAA) as part of the application process. This is a BAA requirement. The BAA application fee for the 2021 Boston Marathon was \$370 plus a \$25 COVID surcharge. Once the invitational entry is submitted to the BAA the fee is non-refundable and the entry is non-transferrable.**
- The runner is responsible for all other costs associated with participation.
- The runner must sign the waiver/disclaimer releasing the City of Framingham from any liability prior to the BAA application being distributed. The waiver/disclaimer can be found below. Please submit a signed copy of the waiver with your application. You may sign it electronically.
- Runners selected by random selection will commit to a fundraising goal of **\$4,000** in support of one of the designated charities, non-profits or programs.
- The runner is responsible for the minimum fundraising obligation of **\$2,000** for a designated organization. Runners who do not attain this minimum by **April 30, 2022** will not be eligible for any future random selections. The list of charitable organizations for which fundraising will be done will be announced following the charity selection process.

- In the event for any reason the in-person 2022 Boston Marathon is not held, there is no guarantee there will be a “roll over” of runners to the 2023 Team Framingham.
- To ensure consistency all runners will use a common fundraising platform determined by the BAA and the Team Framingham Steering Committee.
- Applicants who are selected to participate in Team Framingham 2022 consent to having their photographs that are taken during team training runs and other team events and their individual fundraising totals included in our official Team Framingham press releases and social media postings.
- Runners who are selected to participate in Team Framingham 2022 will comply with any and all public health protocols established for team gatherings, including team meetings and team training runs.
- Applicants who failed to meet the minimum fundraising obligation in previous years as a Team Framingham runner will have their application returned and it will not be included in the random selection.
- At the conclusion of the Team Framingham 2022 fundraising period a presentation will be provided to the Mayor and City Council of Framingham and to the BAA reporting on the 2022 program, including marathon completion status and times and fundraising totals for each of the team runners
- Random selection participants are encouraged to begin a running program prior to the actual selection of the team so that they will have a good “base” for the rigorous training necessary to be fully prepared for the 2022 Boston Marathon.
- Training for and running in a marathon is a physically challenging and demanding undertaking. It is strongly recommended that applicants meet with their primary care physician before engaging in this program, particularly those individuals who have not run before or those who have not engaged in long distance running previously.

**Residency Verification:** Residency will be verified by the City Clerk’s Office utilizing multiple sources (i.e. voter registrations, census information, etc.). In the event that residency cannot be confirmed in this manner, applicants will be required to obtain a Proof of Residency letter from the Clerk. This may require that documents confirming residency be submitted and verified by the Clerk. The deadline to obtain this letter and submit it to the Mayor’s Office will be 4 p.m. on **Tuesday November 30, 2021**. There is a small fee associated with obtaining a Proof of Residency Letter from the Clerk, which is the applicant’s responsibility.

**Employment Verification:** The Human Resources Departments of the City of Framingham, the Framingham Public Schools, Keefe Technical School or the Christa McAuliffe Charter School will be asked to verify year-round or school year employment. You must be employed by one of these four entities on **October 1, 2021** to be considered an “employee” for verification purposes.
