REQUEST OF THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION

UPON THE REQUEST OF THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

That, based on the review of information on traffic violations, accident counts and other data relative to the intersection of Warren Road and Dennison Avenue, and in accordance with the unanimous vote of the Traffic Commission, the City Council affirmed said vote for the installation of All Way Stop Signs at that intersection as defined in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. All documentation is available from the Traffic Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

Pursuant to Article V Section 6 of the Framingham Home Rule Charter, Schedule 2 Stop Signs of Article VIII Section 10, the Framingham Traffic Rules and Orders, originally adopted on September 9, 1973 will be amended by adding:

- Street Stopped —Dennison Avenue westbound at through street Prindiville Avenue
- Street Stopped —Warren Road eastbound at through street Prindiville Avenue

Pursuant to the Framingham Home Rule Charter, Article V Section 6, all rules and regulations promulgated by authorized vote of the Traffic Commission shall become effective on the 30th day following the day on which they are filed with the Council, unless the council within such period by majority of the full council votes to reject said rule or regulation or has sooner voted to affirm it, which shall be February 19, 2019.
