

ORDER FOR JOINT POLE LOCATION

By the City Council of the City of Framingham, Massachusetts notice having been given and a public hearing held, as provided by law, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

That permission be and hereby granted **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC.** and **EVERSOURCE (NSTAR ELECTRIC)** joint or identical locations for and permission to erect and maintain poles and their respective wires and cables to be placed thereon, together with anchors, guys and other such sustaining and protecting fixtures as said Companies may deem necessary, in the public way or ways hereinafter referred to as requested in petition of said Companies dated the 19th day of November, 2018.

MARBLE STREET: Place one (1) jointly owned pole numbered T.1/2 / E.1/2 on the westerly side of Marble Street at a point approximately thirty-two (32) feet southerly from the center line of Waverly Street; and

MARBLE STREET: Relocate one (1) jointly owned pole numbered T.1/E.1 to a point on the westerly side of Marble Street at a point approximately one hundred thirty-seven (137) feet southerly from the center line of Waverly Street; and

MARBLE STREET: Relocate one (1) jointly owned pole numbered T.2/E.2 to a point on the westerly side of Marble Street approximately two hundred ninety-seven (297) feet southerly from the center line of Waverly Street; and

MARBLE STREET: Relocate one (1) jointly owned pole numbered T.3/E.3 to a point on the westerly side of Marble Street approximately four hundred (400) feet southerly from the center line of Waverly Street.

Reason: Place and relocate poles on Marble Street to accommodate a City of Framingham road construction project; and to provide for the distribution of intelligence and telecommunications and for the transmission of high and low voltage electric current.

3 JO Poles to be relocated
1 JO Pole to be placed


All construction under this order shall be in accordance with conditions set forth in a letter dated March 6, 2019 from the Framingham Department of Public Works as well as the following conditions:

Poles shall be of sound timber, and reasonably straight and shall be set substantially at the points indicated upon the plan – **VERIZON No. 1A3D1LP**, Dated November 19, 2018 filed with said petition.

There may be attached to said poles by said **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC.** not to exceed 20 wires and 5 cables and by said **EVERSOURCE (NSTAR ELECTRIC)** such wires, cables and fixtures as are necessary in its business and all of said wires and cables shall be placed at a height in compliance with the National Electrical Safety Code.

Also that permission be and hereby is granted to the said **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND INC.** and **EVERSROUCE (NSTAR ELECTRIC)** to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as may be desired for distributing purposes.

Dear City Council,

The Department of Public Works (DPW) is in receipt of a request from Verizon New England, Inc. and NSTAR Electric to relocate three existing poles and install one new pole, wire, cables and fixtures, including the necessary anchors, guys and other such sustaining and protecting fixtures to be owned and used in common by your petitioners, along and across the following public way or ways of Marble Street in support of installing new JO Pole No. T.1/2/E.1/2, and relocate JO Poles T.1/E.1, T.2/E.2 & T.3/E.3.

We have reviewed this Grant of Location request submitted to the City Council and recommend approval subject to the following conditions:

1. The applicant shall call Dig-safe to mark out the location of the water main before construction.
2. The proposed utility pole (new) shall be installed a minimum five feet away from City utilities. The DPW requests notification prior to the start of work to verify final location in the field.
3. All work shall conform to the City of Framingham construction standards.
4. The proposed work shall be inspected by the City of Framingham DPW to verify that no public utilities are adversely affected.
5. No pole shall interfere with any curb cut or entrance to any property.
6. The area in the vicinity of the work shall be restored and all excess excavation resulting from pole setting shall be removed by the Grantee.





PETITION PLAN
