

ORDER FOR CONDUIT LOCATION

By the City Council of the City of Framingham, Massachusetts notice having been given and a public hearing held, as provided by law, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that**

That permission be and hereby is granted to **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC.** to lay and maintain underground conduits with the wires and cables to be placed thereon, under the surface of the following public way or ways as requested in Petition of said company dated the 17th day of December, 2018.

A STREET: Place six (6) four (4) inch conduit beginning at Verizon Concrete Environmental Vault #44A, located on the northwesterly side of A Street, and then running in a northeasterly direction along the northwesterly side of A Street a distance of approximately one hundred seventy (170) feet to point on the northwesterly side of A Street.

Reason: Place conduit on A Street to provide for the distribution of intelligence and telecommunications.


Substantially as shown on plan marked – Verizon No. 4A0GB1D, dated December 17, 2018, filed with said petition.

Also that permission be and hereby is granted to the said **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND INC.** to lay and maintain underground conduits, manholes, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connection with such poles and buildings as it may desired for distributing purposes.

The foregoing permission is subject to the conditions set forth in a letter dated January 8, 2019 from the Framingham Department of Public Works as well as the following conditions:

1. The conduits and manholes shall be such material and construction and all work done in such manner as to be satisfactory to such municipal officers as may be appointed to the supervision of the work.
2. In every underground main line conduit constructed by said Company hereunder, one duct not less than three inches in diameter shall be reserved and maintained free of charge for the use of the fire and police telephone and telegraph signal wires belonging to the City and used by it exclusively for municipal purposes.
3. Said Company shall indemnify and save the City harmless against all damages, costs and expense whatsoever to which it may be subjected in consequence of the acts or neglect of said Company, its agents or servants, or in any manner arising from the rights and privileges granted it by the City.
4. Said Company shall comply with the requirements of existing ordinances and such as may hereafter be adopted governing the construction and maintenance of conduits and wires, so far as the same are not inconsistent with the laws of the Commonwealth.



Re: A Street - Grant of Location Request – Verizon New England Inc.

Dear City Council,

The Department of Public Works (DPW) is in receipt of a request from Verizon New England Inc. to locate six (6) four (4) conduits to be owned and maintained a total of +/- 170 feet of conduit from Verizon Concrete Environmental Vault #44A, located on the northwesterly side of A Street, and then running in a northeasterly direction along the northwesterly side of A Street, as represented under submitted Grant of Location application package dated December 17, 2018.

We have reviewed this Grant of Location request submitted to the City Council and recommend approval subject to the following conditions:

1. City records indicate there is a municipal conduit located underneath the sidewalk and grass strip at this location on A Street. The applicant shall avoid this conduit or relocate it at their expense.
2. The proposed conduits shall be installed at the location as shown on the plan accompanying the petition. The applicant shall protect the existing municipal conduit. The Department requests notification prior to the start of work to verify final location in the field.
3. The applicant shall obtain a Street Opening Permit for this work.
4. The proposed work shall be inspected by the City of Framingham DPW to verify that no public utilities are adversely affected.
5. The area in the vicinity of the work shall be restored and all excess excavation resulting from the conduit installation shall be removed by the Grantee.
6. All work shall conform to the City of Framingham construction standards.



