**ORDER FOR LOCATION FOR CONDUITS AND MANHOLES
CITY OF FRAMINGHAM**

WHEREAS, NSTAR ELECTRIC COMPANY d/b/a EVERSOURCE ENERGY has petitioned for permission to construct a line for the transmission of electricity for lighting, heating or power under the public way or ways of the City of Framingham, Massachusetts, and notice has been given and a public hearing held, as provided by law,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that NSTAR ELECTRIC d/b/a EVERSOURCE ENERGY be and hereby is granted permission to construct and a location for, such a line of conduits and manholes with the necessary wires and cables therein under the following public way or ways of the City of Framingham:

SHAWMUT TERRACE: Northerly from pole #73/6, approximately thirty-five (35) feet southwest of Brigham Road a distance of thirty-nine (39) ± feet of conduit

Reason: This work is necessary to provide electric service to the City's pumping station.

All construction under this order shall be in accordance with the following conditions:

- 1) Conduits and manholes shall be located as shown on the plan made by A. Debeneditis, Dated March 20, 2018, on file with said petition.
- 2) Said shall comply with the requirements of existing bylaws or ordinances and such as may hereafter be adopted governing the construction and maintenance of conduits and manholes.
- 3) All work shall be done to the satisfaction of the City Council or such officer or officers as it may appoint to supervise the work.

In addition, all construction shall also comply with the following conditions set forth in a letter dated April 24, 2018 from the Department of Public Works:

- 1) The proposed conduit shall be installed at the location as shown on the plan accompanying the petition, specifically, the plan made by A. Debeneditis, Dated March 20, 2018. The Department requests notification prior to the start of work to verify final location in the field.
- 2) The conduits shall be encased in cement concrete.
- 3) The applicant shall obtain a Street Opening Permit for this work.
- 4) The applicant and contractor shall endeavor to maintain 10-foot separation from city-owned utilities at all times.
- 5) The proposed work shall be inspected by the City of Framingham DPW to verify that no public utilities are adversely affected.
- 6) The area in the vicinity of the work shall be restored and all excess excavation resulting from the conduit installation shall be removed by the Grantee.
- 7) All work shall conform to the city of Framingham construction standards

We hereby certify that on **May 15, 2018 at 7:00 PM** at Memorial Hall, 150 Concord Street, Framingham Massachusetts a public hearing was held on the petition of:

NSTAR ELECTRIC COMPANY d/b/a EVERSOURCE ENERGY

for permission to lay and maintain underground conduits, manholes and connections, with the wires and cables to be placed therein, described in the order herewith recorded, and that at least seven days before said hearing a written notice of the time and place of said hearing was mailed to each of the owners of real estate (as determined by the last preceding assessment for taxation) along the ways or parts of ways upon which the Company are permitted to erect poles, wires, cables, fixtures and connections under said order.



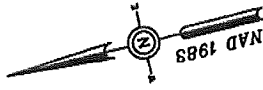

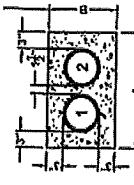


FIG. 1 2-DUCTS

FRAMINGHAM

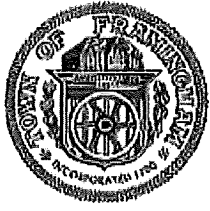
Showing PROPOSED CUSTOMER CONDUIT LOCATION

The Department of Public Works (DPW) is in receipt of a request from NSTAR Electric Company d/b/a EVERSOURCE ENERGY locate (2) 5-inch conduits to be owned and maintained a total of +/- 39feet of conduit from Verizon P73/6 on Shawmut Terrace to point of pick up, along and across the following public way of Shawmut Terrace as represented under submitted Grant of Location application package dated March 29, 2018.
