ORDER NO. 2019-083
REQUEST OF THE MAYOR AND CITY SOLICITOR

UPON THE REQUEST OF THE MAYOR AND CITY SOLICITOR THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

That the City Council votes to amend Article II, Section 13 of the General Bylaws as follows, specifically, that the following new subsection is added to Article II, Section 13 of the General Bylaws:

13.5 The land on 535 Union Avenue (Parcel ID 101-52-8023-000), the current site of the Callahan Center, and other properties that may be developed for this use, shall be used exclusively as a senior center, unless approved to change by the Mayor upon the recommendation of the Council on Aging as well as a 2/3 vote of the City Council. Short term use (a single meeting or repetitive activity lasting no longer than 30 days, such as a class or workshop, etc.) of the Callahan Center as well as any other properties that may be developed for this use, for other purposes may be authorized by the Mayor upon the recommendation by a majority vote of the Council on Aging. In the event of an emergency in the community where time is of the essence, the Mayor or their designee, in his or her discretion, may authorize the use of the Callahan Center or other properties developed for the same use, for up to 72 hours to assist in managing said emergency in consultation with the Council on Aging Chair and/or the Emergency Management Director, as appropriate.

It is noted that the City Council approved two readings of the amendment to the bylaw. When the bylaw amendment was presented for the Mayor's signature, an additional amendment was proposed, resulting in the third vote recorded in this Order.
