REQUEST OF THE PLANNING BOARD

UPON THE REQUEST OF THE PLANNING BOARD, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

That, based on a unanimous vote of the Planning Board on October 24, 2019, the City Council voted the following at a duly posted and advertised public hearing on November 7, 2019, relative to the discontinuance of a portion of Carlson Road, f/k/a Duggan Drive, as a public way:

(1) The City Council votes to hear the Report of the City Council to the Mayor relative to the discontinuance and abandonment of a portion of Carlson Road, formerly Duggan Drive, which was accepted as a public way by a vote of Town meeting on October 28, 1953;
