REQUEST OF THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION

UPON THE REQUEST OF THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the favorable vote of the Traffic Commission on May 26, 2020, the City Council votes to establish an All Way STOP at the intersection of Bethany Road at Winthrop Street with the placement of new STOP signs on both Winthrop Street Approaches. All documentation is available from the Traffic Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

Pursuant to Article V Section 6 of the Framingham Home Rule Charter, Schedule 2 Stop Signs of Article VIII Section 10, the Framingham Traffic Rules and Orders, originally adopted on September 9, 1973 will be amended by adding:

- Street Stopped – Winthrop Street westbound at side street Bethany Road
- Street Stopped – Winthrop Street eastbound at side street Bethany Road

Pursuant to the Framingham Home Rule Charter, Article V Section 6, all rules and regulations promulgated by authorized vote of the Traffic Commission shall become effective on the 30th day following the day on which notice of proposed rule or regulation is filed with the council, unless the council shall within such period by majority of the full council vote to reject such rule or regulation or has sooner voted to affirm it. In accordance with the council’s vote, this change is effective today.
