REQUEST OF THE FINANCE SUBCOMMITTEE

UPON THE REQUEST OF THE FINANCE SUBCOMMITTEE, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

That the City Council votes to appropriate \$324,700 from mitigation funds received for the Blackberry Pump Station project as outlined in the Planning Board decision for the 175 Millwood Street development project as voted on the September 12, 2019 Planning Board meeting. This appropriation will be managed by the Mayor, or her designee, including the Department of Public Works.
