BID #: PW-446 BEEBE AND DOESKIN TANK CLEANING

The City of Framingham (City), Department of Public Works (DPW), invites sealed bids for a project that consists of furnishing all necessary labor, materials and equipment to accomplish the cleaning and repairs of potable water storage tanks. The tanks include two concrete tanks (Beebe Site) - 1 million gallons and 300 thousand gallons, and one glass fused steel tank (Doeskin Site) - 200,000 gallons. These three tanks will require being taken out of service for comprehensive cleaning and repair. Replacement of the Cathodic Protection at the Doeskin Tank will be an Add Alternate No. 1 bid item and Removing Sediment at the Merriam Hill Tank will be an Add Alternate No. 2 bid item.

Sealed bids shall be submitted electronically in strict conformance with the bid documents through the City of Framingham's Department of Public Works Vendor Registry portal <https://vrapp.vendorregistry.com/Bids/View/BidsList?BuyerId=75c3b765-3725-4b32-9689-fc820e50b9c8> until **1:00 P.M. on Thursday, October 8, 2020.**
