ORDER NO. 2020-103 REQUEST OF POLICE OFFICER JAMES GREEN

UPON THE REQUEST OF POLICE OFFICER JAMES GREEN, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

The City Council votes to request that the Mayor petition the General Court for special legislation to extend the employment of Officer James Green from February 4, 2021 to February 4, 2023, provided that Officer Green is mentally and physically capable of performing the duties of the position, that if requested, Officer Green shall, at his own expense, be examined by an impartial physician designated by the city to determine his capacity, that no further deductions shall be made from the regular compensation of Officer Green pursuant to chapter 32 of the General Laws for any service subsequent to February 4, 2021 and that upon retirement, Officer Green shall receive a superannuation retirement allowance equal to that which he would have been entitled had he retired on February 4, 2021.
