Virtual Neighborhood Meeting – Nobscot Intersection Improvements Project

FRAMINGHAM, MA - The City of Framingham Department of Public Works will host a virtual neighborhood meeting via Zoom on Thursday, March 18, at 6 p.m., to review construction plans and anticipated impacts for the [Nobscot Intersection Improvements Project](#).

City staff and the design consultant will present information about the project, including pedestrian safety and access improvements, replacement of the existing traffic signals, roadway geometry modifications, streetscape and drainage improvements, ornamental street lighting, sidewalk replacement, and new roadway pavement. The project will require detours and road closures over the course of construction.
