REQUEST OF THE PRESIDENT OF LOCAL 1652 FRAMINGHAM FIREFIGHTERS' UNION

UPON THE REQUEST OF THE PRESIDENT OF LOCAL 1652 FRAMINGHAM FIREFIGHTERS' UNION, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

That the City Council votes to request that the Mayor petition the General Court for a special act in the form set forth below, authorizing the eligibility, certification and appointment of Michael Smith as a firefighter in the City of Framingham, and authorize the General Court to make any revisions that are necessary or appropriate to the form of such bill.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding section 26 of chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the personnel administrator of the human resources division shall place on the current civil service eligible list for firefighter in the City of Framingham, or on the next list if the current list has expired, Michael Smith, having passed the Civil Service examination in March 2021, on the top of such list requested by the City from the division or delegee from which the next original appointment to the position of firefighter shall be made by the City.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.


