UPON THE REQUEST OF THE FRAMINGHAM PUBLIC SCHOOLS, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

Having convened in an open meeting on May 18, 2021, the City Council of Framingham in accordance with its charter, bylaws, and ordinances, votes to authorize the School Superintendent to submit to the Massachusetts School Building Authority the Statement of Interest Form for the Charlotte Dunning Elementary School located at 48 Frost Street, Framingham, MA 01701 which describes and explains the following deficiencies and the priority category(s) for which an application may be submitted to the Massachusetts School Building Authority in the future:

The roof was repaired in 2018 with an extended 5 year warranty that expires in 2023. Visually, the roof appears to be in good condition with nominal past leakage issues. The front canopy of the roof has been problematic. Recommend moisture survey to identify locations of sub-surface moisture.
