**Framingham, MA** – The City of Framingham’s Office of Public Health Nursing Walk-In Clinic, located at 113 Concord Street (diagonally from City Hall), will reopen to the public on Monday, July 12.

Childhood vaccinations, lead screening, TB testing, and COVID-19 vaccinations (Johnson and Johnson, Moderna, and Pfizer), and more will be available.
