State's Project Beacon Walk-through COVID-19 Testing Site at Saint Tarcisus Parish in Framingham is Open on Labor Day - Monday, September 6;

Reminder: The Memorial Building and other Non-essential Municipal Buildings, including the Public Health Nursing Clinic, will be Closed Monday, September 6, in Recognition of the Labor Day Holiday

The State's Stop the Spread walk-through COVID-19 testing site by Project Beacon at Saint Tarcisus Parish on Waverly Street to be open on the Labor Day Holiday - Monday, September 6:

- **Location:** Saint Tarcisus Parish - 562 Waverly Street, Framingham, MA 01702, testing site is located indoors at the Father Maschi Parish Center, behind the parish
- **Eligibility:** Open to all Massachusetts residents over the age of 12 months old; symptomatic and asymptomatic
- **Appointment:** Testing is by appointment only (Monday-Friday). Make an appointment here: <https://app.beacontesting.com/login>
- **Format:** Indoor testing (no vehicle required) at the Father Maschi Parish Center, **pedestrian access only**
- **Limited parking is available** at 562 Waverly Street. Enter on Waverly Ct.
- **Public Transportation:** Framingham Commuter Rail at 417 Waverly St, Framingham, MA 01702 and Framingham MBTA Station (Stop ID: F02)
- **Cost:** FREE; no insurance required
- **Test Results:** Results will be available within 1-3 (business) days after test administration
