Framingham Health Department to Host a Drive-through/Walk-in Flu Vaccine Clinic for Residents at Keefe Vocational Technical High School on Saturday, October 2

Framingham, MA - The Framingham Health Department will host a drive-through/walk-in flu vaccine clinic for residents at Keefe Regional Technical High School, 750 Winter Street, weather permitting, on Saturday, October 2.

The clinic is open to adults 65 years of age and older from 9 – 10 a.m. All ages, six months and older, should attend the clinic from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m.

On the day of the clinic, please bring a copy of your health insurance card and a signed and completed [flu vaccine form](#) **for each person** getting vaccinated. Forms will be available on site. **Face coverings are required.**

The drive-through clinic will only be available for those who bring a completed registration form. If there is inclement weather, the clinic will be held indoors only.

High-dose flu vaccines will be available to older adults aged 65 years and older while supplies last.

No health insurance is required, but if you have insurance, please bring your card. The flu vaccine is quadrivalent (designed to protect against four different flu viruses, including two influenza A viruses and two influenza B viruses). Following this clinic, any remaining doses will be available during [regular hours](#) at the Public Health Nursing Clinics.
