UPON THE REQUEST OF THE FINANCE SUBCOMMITTEE, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

As at its March 27, 2023 meeting, the Community Preservation Committee (CPC) voted to recommend to the City Council a total expenditure of \$1,549,000.00 in Community Preservation Act (CPA) funds for 10 projects. The CPC determined, among other factors, that the recommended projects met the goals expressed in the Community Preservation Plan, provided a public benefit, and addressed a need.

The Council votes to approve the Committee's FY23 recommended projects as presented and attached.


