ORDER NO. 2023-043-001 REQUEST OF THE ORDINANCE AND RULES SUBCOMMITTEE

UPON THE REQUEST OF THE ORDINANCE AND RULES SUBCOMMITTEE, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

That the Council votes to approve an Ordinance changing the number of members on the Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trails Committee. Be it ordained by the Framingham Council, as follows:

SECTION 1.

Article II, Section 33, subsection 2 of the General Ordinances, as adopted on [December 17, 2021](#), shall be amended by replacing subsection 2 as follows:

33.2 The Bicycle, Pedestrian and Trails Committee (the "Committee") is hereby established, consisting of eight (8) members.

Members shall serve for staggered terms of three years, though initially, at establishment of the Committee, member terms shall be of varying lengths (one, two, or three years) as follows:

- a) One member selected by the Disability Commission (three years);
- b) One member selected by the Parks and Recreation Commission (two years);
- c) One youth member between the age of 13 to 22 selected by the Mayor (one years);
- d) One member selected by the Conservation Commission (two years); and,
- e) Four members appointed by the Mayor (1 —three years, 1 —two years, and 2 — one year.)

SECTION 2.

Article I, Section 33, subsection 2.4 of the General Ordinances shall be amended by the "Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee" with the following:

SECTION 3.

This amendment shall not affect the terms of members presently appointed and serving on the Bicycle, Pedestrian and Trails Committee. And Article I, Section 2.1 eligibility requirement to be a registered voter in order to serve on the Bicycle, Pedestrian and Trails Committee is expressly waived for the youth member if the youth member is under eighteen (18) years of age.

SECTION 4.

Severability

If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then such provision shall be considered separately and apart from the remaining provisions, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5.

Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption.
