REQUEST OF THE MAYOR

UPON THE REQUEST OF THE MAYOR, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

That the City Council votes to accept the provisions of Massachusetts general laws Chapter 6A, sections 18O to 18V, inclusive, providing for the establishment of a regional 911 emergency communication district;

That the City Council approves the proposed district agreement filed with the City Council, between the City of Framingham and the Town of Natick, establishing the district and the construction, siting, equipping, administration, operations and maintenance of a regional 911 emergency communication center by the district under the provisions of the proposed district agreement;

That acting through and under the authority of and pursuant to the powers vested in the City Council pursuant to the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 6A, section 18Q, Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 40, Section §4A, and any and every power and authority to it, granted or implied, the City Council votes to enter the proposed district agreement;

That the Mayor is authorized to sign the proposed district agreement, and any amendments and revisions related thereto, on behalf of the City of Framingham;

And that the Mayor is authorized to sign any and all other documents, instruments, and agreements and take any and all other actions necessary or convenient to effectuate the purposes of this Order.
