- Accessible Parking Spaces are subject to review every two (2) years, or when the Traffic Commission deems appropriate. Should the need no longer exist, the sign will be removed.
- When the Accessible Parking Space is no longer needed due to the applicant's change in residence or change in eligibility status, the applicant or a member of his/her household shall notify the Traffic Commission within thirty (30) days of the change.
