Petitions for intersection control or regulation (traffic signal, stop sign, no turn on red, etc.) require a total of six (6) signatures (including petitioner's) of the residential, commercial and/or nonprofit units located within five hundred (500) feet of the affected intersection. One signature per household or business.

Petitions for parking restrictions, truck exclusions, speed limits, traffic calming, and all other traffic regulations, require a total of at least half (50%) of the residential, commercial and/or nonprofit units which abut the affected street or way, provided that in no event shall more than ten (10) signatures (including petitioner's) be required. One signature per household or business.

Signatures are not required for petitions submitted by the Mayor or a City Councilor; Police Chief or Fire Chief for safety reasons; a member of the Traffic Commission; or City Boards or Commissions. Petitions regarding residential on-street handicap parking shall follow the requirements included in the Framingham Traffic, Parking and Transportation Regulations, as amended.

You may obtain more signatures than the minimum, on additional sheets, to show local support for your request.
