LEGAL NOTICE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

The Framingham City Council will hold a **public hearing** on **Tuesday November 18, 2025** at or after **7:00 p.m.** in the Blumer Room, Memorial Building, located at 150 Concord Street, Framingham, Massachusetts, to consider allowing **Eversource Energy** permission to lay and maintain underground gas main and service pipelines under the surface of the following public way or private way:

Colonel James M. Halpin Drive- Framingham- Grant Plan

To install approximately 530' of 6" HDPE intermediate pressure gas main on Colonel James M. Halpin Drive from the intersection of Eames St at Herbert St to private property at #227 Arlington Street. This proposed 6"HDPE intermediate pressure gas main is to support the elimination of the existing 2" Coated Steel high pressure gas main and services to existing buildings at #223-227 Arlington Street.
