## ORDER NO. 2025-086-001 REQUEST OF THE FINANCE SUBCOMMITTEE

UPON THE REQUEST OF THE FINANCE SUBCOMMITTEE, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

That the City of Framingham hereby appropriates the amount of One Hundred and Twenty-Five Thousand (\$125,000) Dollars for the purpose of paying feasibility study and schematic design costs related to a potential Accelerated Repair Project involving replacement of the roof at Potter Road Elementary School located at 492 Potter Road, with a building consisting of 63,600 square feet, located on 12.75 acres of land with a playground, baseball field, basketball courts, multipurpose field, and 80 vehicle-parking spaces, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto (the "Project"), which proposed repair project would materially extend the useful life of the school and preserve an asset that otherwise is capable of supporting the required educational program, and for which the City of Framingham has applied for a grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority (the "MSBA"), said amount to be expended under the direction of the Superintendent of Schools. To meet this appropriation, the Treasurer with the approval of the Mayor, is authorized to borrow said amount under M.G.L. Chapter 44, or any other enabling authority. The City of Framingham acknowledges that the MSBA's grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and if the MSBA's Board of Directors votes to invite the City of Framingham to collaborate with the MSBA on this proposed repair project, any project costs the City of Framingham incurs in excess of any grant that may be approved by and received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the City of Framingham; and that, if invited to collaborate with the MSBA on the proposed repair project, the amount of borrowing authorized pursuant to this vote shall be reduced by any grant amount set forth in the Project Funding Agreement, or Feasibility Study Agreement if applicable, that may be executed between the City of Framingham and the MSBA. Further, that this order shall supersede a like amount of the appropriation and borrowing authorization loan order vote for this Project adopted by the City Council on June 27, 2023 as part of Loan Order #2023-042-002 (the "2023 Loan Order") and any amounts already borrowed or encumbered under the 2023 Loan Order are hereby deemed to be borrowed and encumbered under this Loan Order.
